Junior Membership Registration Notes

Completion of Registration and Medical forms by a parent or guardian, payment of the appropriate subscription and acceptance of the club's "Conditions of Junior Membership and Code of Conduct" are pre-requisites of membership.

Copies of the "Conditions of Junior Membership" are available on request or can be found on the club's website www.aandscc.org. These conditions are fully compliant with the guidelines laid out for Child Protection by the England & Wales Cricket Board (ECB).

Any issues relating to Child Protection should be referred to the Welfare Officer who contact details can be found on the notice board or on the website

The club adheres to both the ECB's One Game Strategy www.ecb.co.uk/ecb/one-game/one-game-strategy and its Club Inclusion & Diversity Policy www.aandscc.org/Docs/DiversityInclusion.pdf. In accordance with these, Juniors must:

- Treat everyone equally and respect the rights and dignity of everyone regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Play within the rules and respect officials and coaches and their decisions.
- Keep to agreed timings for training and matches or inform their manager or coach if they are going to be late,
- Wear suitable kit for training or matches as stated in these conditions and as further stipulated by their manager or coach
- NOT smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club in matches
- NOT consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
- NOT engage in abusive behaviour or physical assault,

Any Junior not complying with this Code of Conduct may be suspended or have their membership terminated.

Club policy on taking photographs etc, transport of children and Juniors playing in adult matches can be found in the Conditions of Membership but can be summarised as follows:-

- Photographs etc are not to be taken without the consent of the parent and child
- Transport to matches and training is the responsibility of the parent
- Juniors playing adult cricket can only change with adults with parental consent.

Parents of Juniors become Non-Playing Members of the Club without further subscription

Under Data Protection legislation, the Club will only use information gathered on forms or by other means for administering cricket *activities* or, to the appropriate authorities, in the event of a medical or Child Protection issue.
